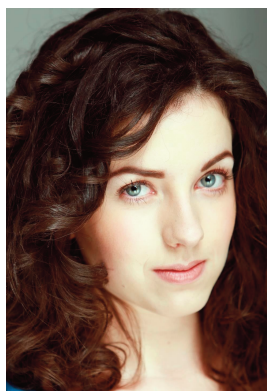

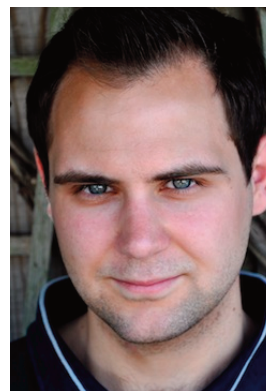

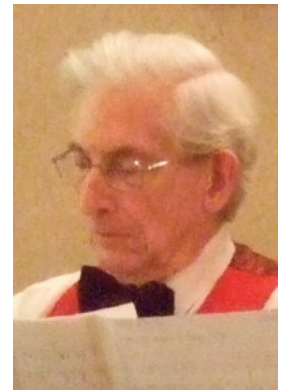

***Why "Late Joys"?***

*At 43 Kings Street, Covent Garden, (then the Grand Hotel.) one proprietor, a Mr Joy, used the vast dining-room to entertain an upper class set of guests. When he handed over to a Mr Evans, the latter, called his entertainments "Evans's, Late Joys". Evans's closed in 1880, but this singularly appropriate title was revived by the Players' Theatre club on December 6th 1937 as "Evans's Song and Supper Rooms (late Joy's)". We have used the title ever since.*
